I have volunteered since its inception, and was elected to the board of directors in 2008 and served as facilities manager.

2007: Began operations of *Wild River Media.com* as web programmer, photographer, writer, and graphic designer. I have built numerous websites that have included custom programming, multimedia presentations, live business forms, and server side program applications. I have published five books, maintained a weblog, and have written numerous public letters and articles. Working with my wife Jane, we have produced thousands of custom note cards, calendars, and other promotional materials and for the City of Watkinsville, for Oconee County, and for individuals. We have hung a number of photographic art exhibitions around the Athens area as well as in Atlanta. I am a certified Adobe Photoshop CS3 Expert.
